



WHITE WINES

- Rumours Chardonnay 2016/17**
Riverina, New South Wales, Australia
Showing typical Australian Chardonnay characters, this wine has fresh green apple and lemon rind aromas. On the palate are ripe peach and melon flavours, a richly textured creaminess and a soft light finish. (2) 12.5% vol

- Agustinos Estate Pinot Gris 2016/17**
Biobio Valley, Chile
A delicious example of this popular grape variety (more commonly seen as Pinot Grigio). Aromas of fresh red apple and ripe quince fruit. The palate is fresh and balanced. (2) 12.5% vol

- The Den Sauvignon Blanc Painted Wolf 2016/17**
Paarl, South Africa
An elegant Sauvignon with soft aromas and flavours of tropical fruits, mineral notes, nettle and subtle oak. The wine is really beautifully balanced with a clean vibrant finish. (2) 13% vol

Rioja, Spain

One for the senses; deep golden colour, tropical aromatics and a palate that bursts with flavours of mango and pineapple. Crisp, dry and harmonious. (1) 13.5% vol

Languedoc, South of France

Lisboa, Portugal
Real finesse with an intense aroma of ripe orchard fruits. The body is full with a delicious, creamy tropical character yet has a fresh, citrus quality and a long finish. (2) 12.5% vol

- Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine Sur Lie 'Bleu' 2016/17**
Loire, France
Traditional, classic Muscadet meets modern day with this quirky bottle design and colour. Full and nicely balanced on the palate with a lingering finish. (1) 12% vol

- Bolitho's Block Sauvignon Blanc 2016/17**
Nelson, New Zealand
This Sauvignon Blanc has rich tropical aromas of mango, melon and ripe citrus. The wine is equally lush on the palate with excellent fruit concentration, a mineral derived texture and a long juicy finish. (1) 12.5% vol

Riverina, New South Wales, Australia

- Short Street Chenin-Grenache-Viognier 2014/15**
Swartland, South Africa
A fresh dry white wine with clean, well-defined fruity flavours associated with wines produced from the old bush vines of Swartland. A blend of Chenin Blanc, Grenache Blanc and Viognier. A slight hint of perfume from the Viognier integrates perfectly with well-balanced natural acidity for a refreshing, mouth-watering finish. (2) 13% vol

- Picpoul de Pinet Cuvée Caroline Famille Morin 2016/17**
Languedoc, South of France
Abounding with fresh aromas of white flowers, acacia and hawthorn; ozone and sea air notes fill the senses and on the palate. It has a roundness from regular lees stirring during winemaking. This is a true 'gourmet' Picpoul. (1) 12.5% vol

Mâconnais, Burgundy, France
Bright favourite from the Latour stable, with fresh grassy notes, plenty of tropical fruit and a firm roundness. Good ripe Chardonnay, with a touch of age. (2) 13% vol

Loire, France
Classic wine from the historical home of Sauvignon. Not only does it have an elegant 'gunflint' minerality, but the grassy, gooseberry fruit carries through the citrus richness. (1) 12.5% vol

Chablis, Burgundy, France
A rich and complex wine with a wonderful, fat structure in the mouth and the charming typical Chardonnay aromas of butter or brioche. Harmonious, fine and elegant with an excellent aromatic linger. (1) 12.5% vol

- Pouilly Fumé Guy Saget 2016/17**
Loire, France
Classic Pouilly from the central vineyards of the Loire. Crisply refreshing aromatic fruit and an underlying suggestion of flint. (1) 12.5% vol

California, USA

RED WINES

- Sepa Moya Merlot 2015/16**
Central Valley, Chile
Chile's signature red, with instantly recognisable plum, mocha and spice notes on the nose, abundant fruit on the palate, and a long finish. The oak influence is very subtle, the fruit forthright and pure. (C) 13% vol

- Finca Monica 2016/17**
Rioja, Spain
Classic Rioja with ripe fruit and elegant oak character. Smooth and tasty wine, sweet tannins and long finish. (C) 13.5% vol

- The Butcher of Buenos Aires Malbec NV**
Mendoza, Argentina
Attractive notes of sweet black cherry and a silky smooth mouthfeel. Not a heavy Malbec but one designed to be versatile with food yet easy enough to drink on its own. (C) 13% vol

- Tor del Colle Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Riserva 2014/15**
Abruzzo, Italy
Intense and concentrated on the nose with cherry flavours and notes of blackberries and liquorice. Dry and herbaceous on the palate, rounded and mouthfilling. (C) 13.5% vol

- Aves del Sur Pinot Noir Reserva 2017/18**
Maule Valley, Chile
Red ruby colour with violet tones. Elegant aromas of cherries, raspberries and strawberries mixed with sweet vanilla notes. Soft and rounded on the palate with smooth tannins. (B) 14% vol

- Casa Vinironia Appassimento 2015/16**
Puglia, Italy
A full-bodied soft wine giving characteristic notes of ripe plum and raisins. Oak ageing adds to the intensity with pleasing notes of spice and vanilla. (D) 14.5% vol

- Bordeaux Rouge Les Origines de Jules Lebègue 2015/16**
Bordeaux, France
Award-winning wine with a delicate bouquet of red fruit such as redcurrant and rasperry, with subtle charred notes. Well-rounded on the palate with hints of wild strawberry and mocha. (C) 13.5% vol

- The Den Pinotage Painted Wolf 2015/16**
Paarl, South Africa
An intense fruit-packed wine with notes of summer berries, savoury spice and toasty cedar wood flavours. The Den wines are comfort wines, and this wine delivers just that. (C) 14% vol

- Baldrick Shiraz Vondeling 2015/16**
Paarl, South Africa
A rich, opulent blend of Mourvedre, Shiraz and a touch of Viognier to give a floral lift. Powerful wine with blackberry fruit, a hint of vanilla and a touch of exotic spiciness. (D) 13.5% vol

- Secret Carménère Viu Manent 2016/17**
Colchagua Valley, Chile
This intense violet-coloured wine stands out for the Carménère's typical spicy character with aromas of black pepper as well as red fruits, berries, and a subtle note of fresh-ground coffee. The medium-bodied palate presents good volume, balance, and a smooth texture that leads to a very pleasing finish. (C) 14.5% vol

- The Duchess Pinot Noir 2014/15**
Marlborough, New Zealand
Crafted by the excellent family-owned Babich Winery, one of New Zealand's most successful wine estates. This wine is elegant and complex, aromatic aromas of fresh red berries, plums and spice. (B) 13% vol

- Cave des Grands Vins de Fleurie 2017/18**
Fleurie, Beaujolais, France
This wine, arrayed in a deep garnet hue flecked with purple, offers up a powerful black fruit bouquet. Notes of slightly tart blackberries give this wine a nice balance. On the palate, the powerful, smooth tannins reinforce the succulent character of this Fleurie, which delivers a lovely, long-lingering finish. (B) 13% vol

- Fincas de Azabache Crianza 2015/16**
Rioja, Spain
Berry jam aromas with hints of balsamic and toasty vanilla. Rich red fruit on the palate with smooth tannins and creamy mocha notes. (C) 13.5% vol

- Hahn Winery Cabernet Sauvignon 2016/17**
California, USA
Inviting red cherry and currant jam aromatics complement notes of vanilla and caramel. Chewy tannins frame hi-tone cherry and berry flavours that carry through the long, smooth finish. (D) 14.5% vol
